

RETURNING TO WORSHIP AT CARRVILLE

Although services will be different, we are delighted we can welcome you to worship once more.

However, **PLEASE NOTE: YOU SHOULD NOT ENTER THE BUILDING IF YOU OR ANYONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD OR BUBBLE HAS SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19.**

To open for worship, we have followed Government legislation and guidelines as well as instructions and advice from the Methodist Church. **The church, foyers, corridor and toilet have been thoroughly cleaned, hand Sanitising Units are in place** at points of entry/exit and **measures are in place to ensure social distancing is observed.**

A one-way system will operate in church. **Entry will be through the glass doors** and everyone **MUST wear a face covering** unless they are medically exempt. Should you forget to bring a face covering then you will be provided with a disposable face mask. On entry you **MUST sanitise your hands** using the touchless unit in the outer foyer (between the two sets of glass doors). All doors into and out of the church will be held open, to minimise contact touching and promote good ventilation.

We will not be taking a collection during the service. Instead, there will be **separate collection plates for each church** on a table **in the foyer** and you may leave your offering on the appropriate plate as you enter church.

You will be **greeted by the Door Stewards** who will be wearing face shields. They will welcome you and **register your arrival on the seating list**; this is **our record of attendance** in line with **NHS 'Track and Trace'**. This **register will be retained for 21 days** to comply with current legislation.

One of the **Door Stewards will guide you to the row where your seat has been allocated.** If you are the first to arrive in that row you will be asked to **move to the farthest available seat(s).** You will be given a **laminated 'X'** to place on **the next two seats**, which will be **left empty to ensure safe social distancing.** Once there you should **remain seated until the end of the service.** The service is expected to last about 45 minutes.

If you should need to use a toilet, please **leave the church via the side door** into the corridor and proceed to the **disabled toilet**; the **other toilets will not be in use.** Please **use the liquid soap and paper towels provided** when washing your hands. You should **return** to church **using the one-way system**, i.e. via the **side door into the main foyer.** Please remember to remain socially distanced when moving into or out of your row.

Sadly, there can be **no congregational singing**, so please avoid the temptation to 'join in' with any music that is played to you.

Please **remain in your seat at the end of the service** until the Steward indicates you may leave. Rows on the same side as the screen will exit first; everyone should **remain socially distanced** as they move towards the exit, **leaving via the side door** and the **door to the car park.** There is a sanitiser unit on the wall near to the exit. Please **sanitise your hands as you leave the building.**

On leaving the building **please do not congregate in groups** but **make your way safely home as soon as possible.**

A SUMMARY OF YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES



DO NOT enter the building if you or a member of your household or bubble has symptoms of Covid-19



SANITISE your hands when entering or leaving the building



WEAR A FACE COVERING AT ALL TIMES IN THE BUILDING unless you are medically exempt. (It is acceptable to wear a face shield if you are medically exempt from wearing a mask)



MAINTAIN A SAFE SOCIAL DISTANCE from people who are not part of your household or social bubble. This should be at least 1.5 – 2m.
