Walking in a group sharing fellowship and our thoughts on a Bible passage - no pre reading is required!

Join us on **Fridays at 10am**

We meet at **Broompark Picnic Area** for a walk along the old railway path.

The walks are along accessible footpaths, walking on the flat. We walk for around 40-50 mins with short pauses on the way to enable and encourage conversation. We begin with a prayer to set us on our way and also share a brief prayer as the chat draws to a close at the end of each walk.

Walks are for all-ages with activities for the young and young-at-heart to explore nature as we walk and talk. Please dress appropriately for the weather: we will continue to walk through the winter months, cancelling only when conditions underfoot make it unsafe to walk. Do, please, feel able to make your own decision as to where walking in winter moves from exhilarating to exhausting.

Broompark Picnic Area is around 1.5 miles to the west of Durham on the road to Ushaw Moor. For SATNAV the postcode is DH7 7RJ. The no. 43 bus, which stops outside, can be boarded at Temporary Stop D on North Road (by the greengrocers)
